Dear Pilgrimage Director

I am writing to you as Chair of the NCSC which is a national commission mandated by the Catholic Bishops' Conference of England and Wales with responsibility for setting the strategic direction of safeguarding policy and monitoring compliance. The NCSC has been informed about safeguarding incidents at the baths in Lourdes. This was discussed at our last meeting and members expressed safeguarding concerns about children and young people being exposed to risk at the baths.

As a result of these concerns, the NCSC is writing to all Pilgrimage Directors to strongly advise that children and young people under the age of 18 years are not encouraged to use the baths unless under parental supervision, and to seek reassurance that use of the baths by children, young people and adults at risk is risk assessed.
